





## BELL TOWER BILINGUAL SCHOOL UNIFORM

### **FOR GIRLS:**

#### Top:

Girls must wear red plain T-shirt on top. When time arrives, school T-shirt will be mandatory. For winter time plain red or navy blue turtle necks, sweaters, or sweatshirts are allowed on plain fabric – no inscriptions of any kind please.

#### Bottom:

Girls are allowed to wear navy blue shorts or skorts. If you choose to wear skirts please, be sure that she wears shorts underneath (also navy blue). If you prefer they must wear long pants also. No zippers or buttons please. Sweat pants are the best when cold time arrives.

### **FOR BOYS:**

#### Top:

Boys wear red plain T-shirt on top. When time arrives, school T-shirt will be mandatory. For winter time plain red or navy blue turtle necks, sweaters, or sweatshirts are allowed on plain fabric – no inscriptions of any kind please.

#### Bottom:

Boys are allowed to wear navy blue shorts or pants. No zippers or buttons please. Sweat pants are the best when cold time arrives.

### **FOR BOTH:**

Everyday Uniform: On top of those, children must wear their everyday uniform (red with blue pocket for 3 years old, blue with red pocket for 4 years old)

Jackets: Jackets could be any color (plain red or blue suggested). Fleece jackets are the best because they are light and warm to wear on top of the everyday uniform. Remember to label all the clothing (including scarves, mittens, gloves, and backpacks.)

Shoes: Shoes must be comfortable and safe. Children are allowed to wear tennis or dress shoes. NO OPEN TOES SHOES are allowed (no sandals of any kind). You will be called if your child is not wearing appropriated shoes. Socks are recommended at all times.

Hair: must be combed and neat always. If your child has long hair, please be sure that will not cover their vision. The overall rules is NEATNESS.

**PLEASE** do not send your children with pants with zippers or buttons! It is too hard for them to handle in an emergency and very uncomfortable when they sleep. Make your child's day a pleasant one...! They run and play a lot so send them with clothes that are comfy for them to wear. Leave your fancy cloth at home for special events. Children need clean, easy to wear and to fix, to play without guilt.

**Students must wear they uniform everyday.** (Please read Parent's Handbook)
